Competition to celebrate the launch of Freedom Art Studio



Bromsgrove-based artist, Wayne Davis, is celebrating the launch of his new studio by teaming up with the Bromsgrove Standard to offer three budding artists the chance to win prizes worth over £150.

Wayne, who used to teach drawing at the Artrix Arts Centre, has based his long-awaited studio in Stoke Prior Craft Centre. Wayne explains why, "I hoped for months that a unit would become available because I loved the convenience of the canalside location. The Priory Café is onsite to cater for daytime courses and the Navigation Pub is on hand for those in need of something stronger! Even Justin from Spud Design, who designed the new logo, is just down the road in Aston Fields.

Stoke Prior Craft Centre is home to another artist, Eric Watson, who specialises in animal portraits, along with a picture framers, a photographer and card craft shops, so I'm enjoying being part of a like-minded arts and crafts community."

The studio offers Wayne the chance to extend the range of drawing and acrylic courses available. He has also set up a small shop selling essential art materials and a gallery showing his cityscape and figurative paintings. He will continue to take commissions for abstract works and his popular child portraits.

The first prize is £50 worth of art materials plus a £50 voucher towards one of Wayne's drawing or acrylic courses. The second prize is £20 worth of materials and a £30 voucher towards a course, and the third prize is a £20 voucher towards a course. The next drawing course starts on 19th June.
